PLANNING FORUMS SCHEDULED FOR THE I & M CANAL NATIONAL HERITAGE CORRIDOR

LaSalle, Illinois – The Canal Corridor Association has been named the local coordinating entity for the development of a comprehensive Management Plan for the I&M Canal National Heritage Corridor in cooperation with the National Park Service. The Plan is required to take into consideration State and local plans and involve residents, local governments and public agencies and private organizations in the Corridor. Among other things, the Plan is to present recommendations for the Corridor's conservation, funding, management and development and to include actions proposed to be taken by units of government and nongovernmental and private organizations to protect the resources of the Corridor.

To gain a diverse community input, four public forums are scheduled to build a foundation of ideas for the generation of the I & M Canal National Heritage Corridor Management Plan. Since the Corridor extends through 49 communities, four initial input sessions will be held along the length of the Corridor. Topics that will require input include: long-term vision, the mission of the Corridor, concepts of a general management plan, continued public input and feedback and the initial stages of the roadmap for the year-long planning process. The forums are scheduled for the week of November 16 as outlined below.

These idea planning sessions will be open to any person that is interested in participating. We ask that you call to make a reservation so that we can plan the sessions and space to accommodate all participants. Follow-up sessions will be scheduled early in 2010 based on the results of the public input and a review by the civic engagement committee and the Canal Corridor Association's Board of Directors.
